Good Job, Class!!




We had seven students. Six of them earned Levels 1 and 2 of the Cooking Medals. One student was only there two days but she earned Level 1.



Former Member and Forever Friend


Maryetta, age 92, passed away after a short illness. She was born in Lake Preston, South Dakota, to Ragner Oden and Florence Teresa Heggelund. They lived in SD until 1942. Her father passed in 1941 and three of her older brothers had been drafted, so the rest of the family moved to San Francisco to live with and Aunt and Uncle. She graduated from Lincoln High School in SFO. Maryetta married Norman Andre on August 7, 1949 and they lived in Tamalpais valley. They had four children before moving to Lake County where they bought a waterfron home in the Buckingham Park subdivision in 1963. The following year their youngest son was born.

In 1968 she got her real estate license and later her brokeræs license and opened Andre Associaes Real Estate with Norman. She was active in Galilee Lutheran Church, Kelseyville Presbyterian Church
